Section B: Problem-Solving Solutions

- 1. Ethical concerns in receiving gifts:
 - Accepting gifts can create a conflict of interest and compromise impartiality.
 - The engineer should decline the gift and report the situation to the appropriate authorities or company management.
- 2. Ethical responsibilities regarding a design flaw:

- The engineer must prioritize public safety over company interests.
- They should report the issue to management and, if necessary, escalate it to regulatory agencies.
- 3. Conflict of interest in consulting:
 - Accepting a contract from a competitor creates a conflict of interest.
 - The engineer should disclose any existing obligations and, if necessary, decline the second contract.
- 4. Signing plans without review:
 - Approving plans without reviewing them violates professional responsibility.
 - The engineer should refuse to sign unless they thoroughly verify the calculations.
- 5. Ethical steps when substandard materials are used:
 - The engineer must ensure compliance with safety standards.
 - They should raise concerns with management and, if ignored, report the issue to regulatory authorities.
